

Confirmation 2021 Q&A

1. What do we do in our Confirmation Small Group Time? Will there be material provided for that?

Your small group time is your church time. This is the time for you to do your own confirmation curriculum. Since each church in attendance is at a different point in their confirmation experience, we do not provide a curriculum.

2. Will churches share spaces in bunkhouses or will the big rooms be closed off to allow more separation?

Churches that choose to sleep in cabins will have their own cabins. For this reason they need a minimum of two volunteers per gender to comply with child protection policies. If a church chooses to stay in hotel rooms we ask that they stick to the 1:6 ratio of adults to youth.

3. When in the schedule would people be able to use the ropes course?

Ropes course is available all of Saturday. It will happen at an assigned time so that facilitators are aware when they are taking a group out. Each group will have a 3 hour time slot on the course. Masks are to be worn on the ropes course.

4. When/where will masks be required and/or suggested?

Masks are required in all common spaces and when in close proximity to people outdoors.

5. Will there be additional hand cleaning stations and/or sanitizing stations?

Hand sanitizer is available throughout the lodge and outside the common areas that will be used during our time together.

6. Can we eat together in the dining rooms?

Dining hall will be open. We ask that masks be worn when getting your food/away from the table, but groups will have the space to dine together.

7. What are the enhanced protocols for cleaning the camp?

We have staff assigned per space, so there will be **Surfaces and handles** wiped down in between sessions. You will have assigned seats during worship, so only your group is using them all weekend long.

8. Will there be a temperature check at registration?

yes and a covid form will be signed

9. Will students be able to sing out loud?

No, we are only doing reflective worship meaning no singing along.
